**SUBJECT:** PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC: (Docket No. UE 249/Advice No. 12-09) Supplements Original Filing of Advice 12-09, Renewable Resources Automatic Adjustment Clause.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

I recommend that Portland General Electric's Advice filing be approved.

**DISCUSSION:**

Portland General Electric (PGE or Company) made a filing on March 29, 2012, for its annual Renewable Resources Automatic Adjustment Clause update pursuant to Schedule 122 of PGE's Tariff. The filing was docketed as UE 249 and a procedural schedule followed. On September 20, 2012, the Commission adopted a stipulation in UE 249 in Order No. 12-359. Pursuant to that Order, PGE is supplementing this filing with updated Schedule 122 Prices.

Special Condition 1 on Schedule 122 specifies that costs recovered or refunded through this schedule will be allocated to each schedule using the applicable schedule's forecasted energy on the basis of an equal percent of generation revenue applied on a cents per kWh basis to each applicable rate schedule.

PGE estimates that the average Schedule 7 Residential customer that consumes 900 kWh monthly will see a reduction in their monthly bill of \$0.14, or approximately 0.1 percent relative to current Schedule 122 prices.
